**Executive Summary**

This document provides the framework for the activities – growth and development, as it were – of the United States Transuranium and Uranium Registries and related programs for the decade commencing with FY96 and continuing through approximately FY05. Major goals or activities planned for the near term – i.e. 1-3 years – largely center around administrative activities and consolidation of Registries functions, which will in turn facilitate the research activities planned by the Registries. For the intermediate term (4-7 years) there will be a shift towards increased utilization of the resources of the National Human Radiobiology Tissue Repository, bioeffects studies, and direct support of epidemiologic studies and the waste cleanup effort, although the traditional biokinetics and dosimetry studies will remain a major focus. For the longer term, the research emphasis will move towards evaluations of mixed chemical and radiological exposures and chemical carcinogens in the workplace.
